### MESSAGE FROM ACHAN

My dear brothers, sisters and beloved children,

Praise Jesus Christ who was crucified!

When this newsletter reaches you, almost all the days of Lent must have been gone by. But a question remains and I would like to pose it before you: "Have we been awake with the Lord

an hour?" (Mathew 26:40). It must be true that this world has forgotten Mary who sat at the feet of the

Lord (Luke 10:41&42). Another question resounding during Lent, is the first question God asked Adam: "Where are you" (Genesis 3:9). Are we with God; are we awake or hiding? An extreme question in this regard would be: Do we even hear these questions from God or have we conveniently shut down our ears to Christ?

Jesus chose His disciples primarily to be with Him (Mark 3:14). Prayer is an encounter with God and being with HIM. No one in this world could deny us an encounter with God and our right to be with Him. Because it is given to us by God Himself (Ephesians 1:2ff). We may be nothing or a failure or a fool in the eyes of the world; or we may not own anything or educated to be so proud in the eyes of the world; or we could be misunderstood and hated by many; or we could lose everything; still, no one could take away our call given from God to be with Him. It is real and true that no matter what, we can be with God. Only one person can block this call of God to be with HIM, that is "I". The willful decision I make either to be awake or to sleep, either to be with God or to hide; either to obey Him or to be indifferent to His commands decides the matter.

When "I" skip prayer thinking that it is too much stressful or hard or something having no results or waste of time etc. or when I choose and prefer TV or internet or some other entertainment to God; I willfully but unknowingly sell my right to be with HIM. Something similar happened to Esau (Genesis 25:34).

Let us examine Jesus' question during this Lent, "Can you stay awake with Me". It is not because Christ gets anything by our being awake with Him. He is always the "I AM". We cannot in fact add or reduce anything in HIM. Being with God is for our salvation. We cannot give anything to God unless it is first given to us. God needs nothing then; because He is the provider of everything. We get everything by being with God and not being with God or hiding from Him make us lose the paradise.

Dear Children of God, remain with God (John15:4-7) in and through prayer. Never skip prayer for any reason; but at least spent ½ an hour with God every day in personal prayer and ½ an hour in family prayer. May Good God bless each one of us and our families during this Lent!
